Day 1. Tues 19 May: Homeport - Myrtleford

Flight Details: Brisbane/Sydney/Adelaide - Melbourne (flight times to be advised)

Lunch & Dinner

This morning we depart Melbourne and make our way up to Bright in North Eastern Victoria to celebrate the wonderful autumn colours and produce of Victoria's Alpine High Country. Just a short drive from out of Melbourne is the home of **The Living Legends** such as Apache Cat, Might and Power and Rogan Josh to name just a few. We are able to rub shoulders with these equine royals, stroll the **Woodlands Homestead** heritage gardens and enjoy lunch **in the Black Caviar Cafe**. Up in **Glenrowan** we take a look through the **Ned Kelly Museum and replica homestead** before a group **photo next to 'Big Ned' himself**. Day 2. Wed 20 May: Mt Beauty - Tawonga Gap - Myrtleford

Light Breakfast & Dinner

Today we head off early down along the scenic Great Alpine Road towards the villages of Mount Beauty and Tawonga, stopping along the way at Tawonga Gap Lookout and Sullivans Lookout to take in the magical autumn vistas. In Mount Beauty we enjoy a cuppa and take in the scenery from the shores of the Mount Beauty Pondage. At the Mount Beauty Information Centre and Museum we enjoy a talk on the history of the Kiewa Valley Hydro scheme before a self-guided tour through the museum. After some leisure time to purchase lunch in town, we travel out to Tawonga to meet up with John and hear his story relating to the amazing Australian Stoewer Museum, a tribute to the family behind Germany's Third Car Manufacturer. Then sit back and enjoy the scenery as we head back to Myrtleford where we catch up with our local historian for an overview of the tobacco growing industry. Starting at the Old School Museum which provides an interesting insight into the township and tobacco industry which was driven mostly by the large number of Italian migrants who settled down in this region in the 1920's. Our day complete and after a rest back at the motel we meet up for dinner.

Day 3. Thurs 21 May: Historic Beechworth - Milawa Cheese

Light Breakfast & Dinner

This morning we travel up to Beechworth where we meet up with our local historian before enjoying our tour of the **Gold Rush History** and **Beechworth walking tour.** After taking a coffee break we tour the **Old Beechworth Gaol**, one of Australia's most significant post-European cultural sites. Its role in the chain of **events that led to the execution of Ned Kelly** is significant as it housed Ned's mother, Ellen Kelly, many of the Kelly sympathisers and Ned himself, alongside his brother Dan and the rest of the Kelly gang. We break for lunch before meeting up at the **Robert O'Hara Burke Museum**, a must visit for anyone visiting the historic township, after a 15 minute talk we are free to take a wander through the displays including the **Chinese, Gold, National History and Ned Kelly Collections.** This afternoon we depart Beechworth and head down to Milawa for our last stop for the day at the **Milawa Cheese Company** to enjoy a tasting and purchase some goodies before returning to our motel to rest before dinner.

Day 4. Fri 22 May: Bright & Wandiligong

Light Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

After breakfast we travel back across the valley to Bright where we will be joined by our local guide who will take us for a **highlights tour of Bright and Porepunkah**. We then travel out through the **National Trust registered Wandiligong Valley** to the village of **Wandiligong** viewing orchards, tobacco farms, nut orchards and autumn colours of the towering Wandi Poplars along the way. We call in at **Nightingale Brothers**, the producers of crisp juicy apples, chestnuts and persimmons. **5 Acres Bar and Kitchen provides the perfect setting for lunch** before heading back into Bright to experience the delightful **Elm Haven Garden**. Our last stop for the day is at the **Australian Pumpkin Seed Company** which specialises specifically in growing a special variety of heirloom pumpkin originating in the founding family's homeland Slovenia. It's then time to relax back at the motel before dinner.

Day 5. Sat 23 May: Bright

Light Breakfast & Dinner

Back across in Bright today we take a look through the **Bright and District Historical Society Museum** situated in the heritage listed old Bright Railway Station. We then meet our **local historian** down at the **Bright State Battery and Mining Museum** at Dougherty's Bridge for some morning tea and wonderful insight into the gold mining and crushing facilities for gold prospectors until it closed in 1994. We then enjoy some leisure time in Bright, browsing some unique shopping and meeting the local characters. Later in the afternoon we head to our last stop for the day which is up at the majestic **Red Stag Deer Farm** for an introduction talk on the 70-acre farm before a chance to feed, touch and learn about deer, emus and ostriches. We also have time to browse the shop or relax and maybe purchase a coffee and giant scone from the cafe while taking in the stunning alpine views including the beautiful Mount Buffalo National Park. After a relaxing drive back to Myrtleford we enjoy a freshen up before dinner.
